SUBJECT: Lane Closures in Minnehaha County

Minnehaha County is currently constructing a guardrail improvement project adjacent to several drainage structures throughout the County Highway System. Traffic has previously been delayed due to work on the following road sections:

- 483rd Avenue (County Highway 111) approximately ¼ mile north of South Dakota Highway 42
- 472nd Avenue (County Highway 133) approximately ½ mile north of 254th Street (County Highway 122)
- 464th Avenue (County Highway 149) approximately ½ mile south of Colton

Traffic will soon be delayed at the following location due to a new road closure:

- Ellis Road (County Highway 139) approximately 1/3 mile south of South Dakota Highway 38

Motorists may experience delays when traveling on these routes and are encouraged to use alternate routes.

These closures are expected to last approximately two weeks and will be followed by lane closures at additional structures. Future lane closures and road closures will be announced on social media and via a news release.
