The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), Minnehaha County, City of Sioux Falls, City of Brandon, and Sioux Falls Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will host a public informational meeting and open house to receive public input on the Maple Street / Park Street Corridor Study. The corridor limits are from Veterans Parkway to SD11. The open house will allow for one-on-one discussion with the study team. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the study goals and collect general public input. Area residents, business owners, and daily commuters are encouraged to attend and participate in the study.

A brief presentation will take place at 6:05 p.m. SDDOT, Minnehaha County, City of Sioux Falls, City of Brandon, Sioux Falls MPO, and consultant staff will be available after the presentation to discuss the corridor study and answer your questions. During this time, you will also have the opportunity to present written comments. For those that cannot attend in person, information can be found at www.SDDOT.com.

The website will be updated with the meeting materials presented at the public meeting no later than November 30th, 2018. The website also allows for questions to be asked and project information to be reviewed.
